	Roadway Repair & Resurfacing 2017



Authorize the Mayor to sign and submit the application for the 2017 Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) program for improvements to the proposed street improvement list provided in the staff memo.

BUDGET IMPACT

The project will be included in the annual capital improvement budget and a portion of the project cost will be funded by state funds, estimated at \$181,604.12 with an additional \$150,000 programmed from potential SPLOST proceeds in 2017.

DISCUSSION

The resurfacing program has focused over the last two years on rebuilding roads annexed several years ago on the southern end of the city through the larger industrial sectors. The two most recent projects involved the reconstruction of both Brogdon Road and Way.

Staff will be working in the next couple of months on a pavement rating system with the assistance of one of our engineering consultants. In the interim, our road staff has been monitoring a number of growing pavement failures around the city and has proposed the following locations and roads be submitted for repair under the resurfacing program for 2017.

In addition, the 2017 budget proposal will include moving more of the paving operations in-house with additional equipment and personnel so that the projects can be delivered faster and more cost-effectively. Depending on availability of the equipment and the length of time required to bring on staff, the 2017 repairs are


most likely going to be outsourced with the intent of transitioning to an in-house solution for later years. These decisions will be determined on the basis of extent of the scope and availability of staff resources.

2017 Street List:

- 1. Waltham Lane Repair, edge mill and overlay
- 2. Bathgate Court Repair, edge mill and overlay
- 3. Glen Level Drive Repair, edge mill and overlay
- 4. Whitehead Road Repair, mill and partial overlay
- 5. Hillcrest Drive Repair, mill and partial overlay
- 6. Craig Drive Repair, mill and partial overlay
- 7. Arbor View Lane Repair, mill, and partial overlay
- 8. Nature Path Lane Repair, mill and partial overlay
- 9. Wild Timber Road Repair, mill and partial overlay
