The City of Sugar Hill Council held a called council meeting on Tuesday December 19, 2000 at 8:00 AM in the Community Center Conference Room.

Notice of the meeting was placed on the doors of city hall and the community center. Notice was placed on the board at Peachtree Industrial Blvd and Alton Tucker Blvd. Notice was sent to the local news media.

Those present at the meeting included Mayor Roberta Crabb, Mayor Pro-Tem Gary Pirkle, Council Members Chris Abbey, Meg Avery and Kim Hall, City Manager Frank Ginn, Finance Director Kelley Canady and City Clerk Shirley Gibbs.

Mayor Crabb called the meeting to order at 8:50 AM due to the bad weather which prevented people from arriving on time.

Council Member Abbey made a motion to enter into Public Hearing. Mayor Pro-Tem Pirkle made the second. Motion passed 4-0.

Council Member Hall had question regarding the \$80,000.00 for equipment lease at the golf course, she would like to see it reduced to \$40,000.00. Discussion was held and it was determined to leave this item at \$80,000.00. Council Member Hall recommended putting the \$202,785 in the contingency fund from previous year revenues or show it as a credit note on the budget that this money had been allocated to the street department for paving.

Discussion was held on this item. Council Member Abbey made a motion to exit Public Hearing. Mayor Pro-Tem Pirkle made the second. Motion passed 4-0. Council Member Abbey made a motion to adopt the 2001 Budget with the changes noted. Mayor Pro-Tem Pirkle made the second. Motion passed on a vote of 3-1. Council Member Hall was opposed to the motion.

Council Member Hall made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Avery made the second. Motion passed 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:45 AM
