CALL TO ORDER, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG AND INVOCATION:

Mayor Crabb called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and gave the Invocation.

NEW BUSINESS:

A: PUBLIC HEARING: APPROVAL OF 2002 BUDGET:

City Manager Hail stated that this budget was the results of two prior hearings. He gave a summary of some of the changes that had been made to the budget including the following: there would not be another prison crew for the 2002 year until maybe later in the year, the Springhill Drive project did not include a sidewalk. Other items discussed were insurance tax, residential building permit fees, and postage, contract labor. After some more discussion, Council Member Hall made the motion to adopt the 2002 Budget as printed. Council Member Avery made the second. Motion passed unanimously by those present to vote 3-0.
