The City of Sugar Hill held a Special Called Meeting on Thursday August 2, 2001 at 7:00 PM in the Community Center.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:**

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**A: AMENDMENT OF ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ORDINANCE:**

City Manager Hail gave a brief overview of the necessity to change the Adult Entertainment Ordinance. City Attorney Thompson explained some of the issues that needed to be changed in order for the Ordinance not to be considered unconstitutional. Some of the changes included the time frame that the city had to investigate the application and the background of the applicant and to let the applicant know if it was approved or denied and the reason for the denial or approval. Other changes included the appeal process, the prohibition of enclosed viewing rooms, the booths had to be open on one side or have a glass wall, only one person at a time could occupy the viewing room. Discussion was held between the Council and City Attorney. Council Member Hall made the motion to approve the amendment to the Adult Entertainment Ordinance. Mayor Pro-Tem Abbey made the second. Motion passed unanimously 5-0.
