

City of Sugar Hill Called Council Meeting

The City of Sugar Hill Council held a called council meeting on Thursday April 12, 2001 at 6:30 PM in the community center.

Notice of the meeting was placed on the doors of city hall and the community center.

Notice was placed on the board at Alton Tucker Blvd and Peachtree Industrial Blvd.

Those present at the meeting included Mayor Roberta Crabb, Mayor Pro-Tem Chris Abbey, Council Members Meg Avery, Kim Hall, Michael Mosley and Gary Pirkle. Also present were City Attorney Lee Thompson, Acting City Manager Jim Osborn, City Clerk Shirley Gibbs, and Potential City Manager Robert Hail.

CALL TO ORDER, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG AND INVOCATION:

Mayor Crabb called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Council Member Michael Mosley gave the Invocation.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: TO DISCUSS PERSONNEL ISSUES:

Council Member Pirkle made the motion to enter into Executive Session to discuss Personnel Issues. Council Member Avery made the second. Motion passed unanimously 5-0.

A motion was made and seconded to return to regular session. Motion passed unanimously 5-0.

NEW BUSINESS:

A: PUBLIC ACTION RELATED TO PERSONNEL ISSUES:

Council Member Mosley made the motion to hire Mr. Robert Hail as the new city manager with a salary of \$65,000 and benefits as discussed. He would let the council know when his start date would be. Mayor Pro-Tem Abbey made the second. Motion passed unanimously 5-0.

B; RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT CDBG APPLICATION FOR ELEVATOR ADA IMPROVEMENT:

Planning Director Jim Osborn explained this Resolution needed to be approved in order to receive funding for a CDBG Grant to install an elevator. The plan is to install an elevator in city hall then moving the Planning Department upstairs. The elevator along with modifications to the upstairs bathroom would bring into ADA compliance. Once the Planning Department was moved upstairs the plan was to remove the house they are currently in and make more parking space. Council Member Hall made the motion to approve the Resolution. Mayor Pro-Tem Abbey made the second. Motion passed 5-0.
