APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

Mayor Pro-Tem Abbey made the motion to approve the agenda. Council Member Hall made the second. Motion passed unanimously by those present to vote. 3-0

NEW BUSINESS:

A: APPOINT AND SWEAR IN COUNCIL MEMBER TO REPLACE GARY PIRKLE:

Mayor Pro-Tem Abbey made the motion to appoint Thomas A Rhodes, who is running unopposed to succeed Gary Pirkle, to fill the council seat vacated by Gary Pirkle. Mr. Pirkle resigned in order to run for the Mayor's position. Council Member Hall made the second. Motion passed unanimously by those present to vote. 3-0. Mayor Crabb asked Mr. Rhodes to come forward to be sworn in. After being sworn in, Council Member Rhodes took his place on the council.

Council Member Rhodes made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Mayor Pro-Tem Abbey made the second. Motion passed unanimously by those present to vote. 4-0.
