

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
MAYOR & CITY COUNCIL
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2003
8:00 A.M. COMMUNITY CENTER**

Mayor Pirkle called the meeting to order at 8:09 a.m. and determined that a quorum was present. Present were Mayor Pirkle, Mayor Pro Tem Avery, Council Members Hall and Johnson, City Manager Bob Hail and City Clerk Jane Whittington.

The Mayor and Council considered a Resolution to accept the resignation of Thomas Rhodes who resigned to accept a position with the State Department. The resolution also directs the Election Superintendent to call a Special Election in order to fill the vacancy on the Sugar Hill City Council created by his resignation from Post 4. The Special Election shall be held on the same date as the general municipal election scheduled for Tuesday, November 4, 2003.

Council Member Hall motioned to approve the resolution to accept Thomas Rhodes' resignation and call for a Special Election to fill the remainder of his term. Mayor Pro Tem Avery seconded the motion. Approved 3-0.

Qualifying dates for Special Election – The resolution further sets the qualifying dates for such election to be Monday, September 29, 2003 through Wednesday, October 1, 2003. The qualifying will be open each day from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. as required by state law. The qualifying fee will be \$108.00.

Council Member Hall motioned to approve the qualifying as stated above. Mayor Pro Tem Avery seconded the motion. Approved 3-0.

Council Member Hall motioned to adjourn. Mayor Pro Tem Avery seconded the motion. Approved 3-0.
