Highway 20 Update

The Highway 20 Improvement Project remains in final design. Construction is scheduled to begin in July 2010. There has been some delay because of the Environmental Surveys and Reports that are required by the State of Georgia. Once the environmental report is completed, Right of Way acquisitions can begin in approximately six (6) months. A few acquisitions have already taken place to preclude unwanted or project interference development of needed land for the road project.

Co-Ed Flag Football



The City of Sugar Hill and i9 Sports are excited to offer the Sugar Hill community the first **Co-ed** Flag Football league in Sugar Hill (Ages 5-12). The season begins September 16th and will conclude November 18th at E.E. Robinson Park. All games and practices are played on Sunday afternoons beginning at approximately 1PM. The program is very convenient for our parents. It is **ONLY** a ONE day, 2-hour commitment per player. Yard Sale Permits

A yard sale is defined as the selling or displaying of goods outside of an enclosed permanent structure including, but not limited to, the selling or displaying of goods in the area commonly known as the carport or garage of a residence or the area commonly known as the yard of a residence. Anyone conducting a yard sale from property zoned for residential purposes must obtain a yard sale permit from the city. Permits are available at City Hall in the Customer Service Department. They are approved for a period not to exceed three days (72 hours) and shall state the time and date the sale is to begin and end. No more than four permits for any one location within a 12-month period. Permits are free and sign regulations are provided at the time a permit is received.
