The retention/detention amenity pond on West Broad Street is progressing now that we've had some dry weather. The pond liner is complete and retaining walls can be seen in the photographs. Trees have been planted with many more to be installed. Our next step is another large retaining wall and terracing.

News Bites:

- In June, Plaza Security began enforcing City Code violations throughout the City and issuing parking citations for illegal parking at our City parks. Due to the popularity of our parks, illegal vehicle parking has become an issue, especially on weekends. Please park in the Level Creek lot at EE Robinson Park and in the Gary Pirkle Park upper lot on Suwanee Dam Rd., or in the cleared lot across from the main entrance at Gary Pirkle Park.
- **“Reels at Robinson”** presents **“Mega Mind”** the evening of July 29th, it is rated PG and is family friendly. All movies start at dusk in the amphitheater at E. E. Robinson Park and are FREE to attend.
- Sugar Hill is one of a few cities that proactively controls mosquito breeding grounds as a free service to our residents. We will continue mosquito spraying throughout July. The spray becomes inert when exposed to water or sunlight so the spraying is done in the evening when mosquitoes are active. The second round starts July 11-15th, north of Hwy 20 and runs through July 18-22nd, south of Hwy 20.
- Please welcome to our City, the young volunteers from the World Changers. Who will be here July 25 - 30th to work on resident homes. Their efforts have been funded by the Sugar Hill Housing Authority again this year and they will build handicap ramps, paint homes, rebuild roofs, and replace rotted siding. These young adults pay their own way to Cities all across the United States to work a week improving lives in communities like Sugar Hill.
