Alert!!!!

It is "Home Repair Scam" season!! Several residents of Sugar Hill have been victimized by persons representing themselves as home repair specialists.

If you are approached by anyone to perform home repairs, ask to see their City of Sugar Hill Solicitor's Permit. **If you become afraid, or feel intimidated, call 911 immediately.** Try to remember vehicle tag numbers and type of vehicles to assist the police.

Home Security Surveys

Gwinnett County Police Crime Prevention Unit offers home security surveys free of charge. The surveyor will look at several items in and around your home and make recommendations for improvement concerning: doors, window, lighting, landscaping and alarm equipment. Trash Pick-Up - Optional Services

- "Special Bag" is sold by the box which includes twenty (20) bags. Each box of 20 bags is \$22.32 per box. Remember, this includes the cost of curbside recycling.
- **Only the contents within the roll-away carts will be collected.** The cost of this service is \$10.90 per month for a **90-gallon cart** and \$8.90 per month for a **35-gallon cart**, billed quarterly at \$32.70 and \$26.70 respectively.
- "Bulky Waste" must have one (1) "Special Bag" attached to each item and be easily visible to the collection crew.

Place your "Special Bags" garbage carts, recycling bins, and bulky items within five (5) feet of the curb or roadside by 7 AM each Wednesday.

Note: Residents can call any company that specializes in the removal of hazardous materials. For example, SHINALL RECYCLING, 770-564-1511, will also dispose of appliances which might be more cost effective.
