POLLING LOCATION CHANGED FOR CITY ELECTIONS QUALIFYING HELD IN SEPTEMBER

City of Sugar Hill residents will now vote at the new Community Center located at 1166 Church Street. The City will have an **election Tuesday, November 8, 2005** for the Mayor and two Council seats. **Qualifying for these offices will be Monday, September 12, 2005 from 8:30 a.m. to Friday, September 16, 2005 at 4:30 p.m.** The qualifying fee for Mayor is \$162 and for Council is \$108. You must be a registered voter and a resident of the City of Sugar Hill for a period of one year prior to the election date to qualify for office.
