RENEW YOUR VEHICLE REGISTRATION ON THE INTERNET!

There is no longer a need to go into the Gwinnett Tag Office or mail a check to renew your vehicle registration and tag. It is fast and easy to renew via the internet and can be done in the comfort of your home. To access the registration website, navigate to www.gwinnett-tag.com and click on "Renew Online." The Georgia Dept. of Motor Vehicle Safety charges a fee of \$4.70 for this transaction. Please note that renewals online cannot be processed if you need to make any changes, such as change of address.
