Sugar Hill's Educators Take Top Honors

Sugar Hill Elementary Principal, **Sandra Levent**, was recently recognized by the Georgia PTA as a **2005 Outstanding Principal of the Year**. Principal Levent, in her 33rd year as an educator, was one of ten administrators in the state to receive this prestigious award. The Mayor and City Council presented her with a proclamation at the March Council Meeting congratulating her as a motivational leader and an asset to the community.

Leanne Luttrell, a Sycamore Elementary School Teacher, was selected by President Bush for the **2004 Presidential Award for Excellence in Math**. She was the only teacher in Georgia and one of 95 elementary and middle school teachers nationwide to receive this honor. President Bush commended her "for embodying excellence in teaching, for devotion to the learning needs of the students, and for upholding the high standards that exemplify American education at its finest." Ms. Luttrell was also honored by the Mayor and City Council April 11th.


