## BUSINESS LICENSE & OCCUPATION TAX

All City of Sugar Hill Business Licenses will expire on January 31, 2007. Your gross receipts must be filed with the City Clerk's office so the Occupation Tax can be calculated. Applications for renewal will be sent in December. It is crucial for all businesses to make any changes on the application and to fill in the portion requesting **gross receipts** or the number of professionals and mail this back to the City. Invoices will then be generated and mailed. The licenses will be mailed upon receipt of payment. If you have any questions about the Business License process, check the City's website or call the City Clerk at (770) 945-6716.

**Alcohol/Ber and Wine Licenses are due December 31, 2006.** The application must be completely filled out, signed, notarized and mailed back or brought into the Clerk's office by the expiration date. This renewal date is different from the Business License so be sure your renewal is complete by the end of this year. Any questions about the renewal process call the City Clerk at (770) 945-6716.
