Sugar Hill Passes Change to Pet Ordinance

SUMMARY: Dogs must be fenced or on a leash at all times.



- It shall be the duty of every owner or custodian of any dog to ensure that the dog is kept under restraint and that reasonable care and precautions are taken to prevent the dog from leaving the real property limits of its owners, possessor, or custodian, and ensure that:
 - It is securely and humanly restrained by chain, cable or trolley, invisible containment system, or other tether of sufficient strength to prevent escape.
 - It shall be the duty of the owner or custodian of any dog to keep the dog under restraint and control at all times while the dog is off the real property limits of the owner, possessor or custodian (securely restrained by a leash or other device held by a competent person).

Open Season for Natural Gas Level Billing

In the near future, you will receive an informational flier in your natural gas invoice for the City's 2006-2007 Level Billing application process. You can also find this information on the City website www.cityofsugarhill.com. Select the icon on the homepage. This will lead you to more information and a printable form for your convenience. **A signed agreement**, by the account owner, must be brought to City Hall (mailed, placed in the night drop or faxed to (770) 945-0281).

After May 1st, you can call City Hall (770) 945-6716, to find out what your monthly level bill would be. This monthly bill amount must be on the signed agreement. You will need your home address and account number to request this information.

Deadline for signing up for next year's program is June 10, 2006.
