NATURAL GAS – Be Safe

When we think about providing natural gas to our citizens, we focus on safety and keeping costs as low as possible.

The meters and regulators that bring the natural gas to your home or businesses are the property of the City of Sugar Hill. With a focus on the safety of all customers, we ask that you not tamper with any part of the meter or meter box. Tampering with any part of the gas system can pose a danger for both the resident and neighbors. The City assesses a minimum \$100 fee if this occurs. Please call the Gas Dept. at (770) 271-2137 or City Hall if you have any questions or concerns or suspect misuse of the gas system.

The City of Sugar Hill owns and operates a gas system in and around its city boundaries.

ENERGY SAVING TIPS

- 1) Fireplaces draw large amounts of heated air from inside your home. Close the damper when not using the fireplace.
- 2) Set your thermostat to 68 degrees.
- 3) Wear warm layered clothing when inside.
- 4) Replace or clean furnace filters once a month.
- 5) Reduce hot water temperature.
- 6) Do only full loads when using the clothes washer and dryer.
- 7) Clean the dryer lint trap after each use.
- 8) Wash only full loads in the dishwasher and washing machine.
