## PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT FOR SUGAR HILL GAS CUSTOMERS

### If the Smell of Gas is Strong in your Home:

- 1) Please call the Sugar Hill Gas Department at (77) 271-2137 or (770) 945-6716, 24 hours.
- 2) Open doors and windows to ventilate your home.
- 3) Shut off all gas appliance valves.
- 4) Don't use any machines; operate any electrical appliances or switches, including light switches.
- 5) Leave the house. Make your emergency call from a neighbor's home. Remain there until a certified gas technician arrives.

Sugar Hill operates a safe, well maintained underground gas system in accordance with Federal Regulations. Any underground gas piping beyond the meter is the responsibility of the customer. If not properly maintained, metallic pipes, may be subject to corrosion. Make sure any underground gas piping beyond the meter is properly maintained.

### Call Before You Dig:

Please contact the Georgia One Call Center at (770) 632-4344 or call 811, three days prior to digging in order for all utility-owned buried pipe and cable to be located. All digging should be carefully done by hand in the vicinity of the pipe. This service is available to you free of charge.
