# Sugar Hill Welcomes Kroger

The Kroger grocery store chain is committed to build in the City of Sugar Hill, what will be the largest Kroger in Georgia at the corner of Suwanee Dam Road & Hwy 20.

At 101,000 sq. ft. this store will be the new standard size store layout and dwarf other grocery stores in the surrounding area. The building will be built according to Sugar Hill's architectural standards using brick and stone. The fuel pumps will also meet our goals for attractive new construction with a pitched roof and brick pillars. The store will have enclosed loading docks for noise abatement. The 27 acre shopping center will fea-

ture several outbuildings for shops, restaurants, and offices. The center will bring 450 new jobs to Sugar Hill. Kroger will employ 250, and the outparcels will provide 200 additional jobs. This store will have the ability to expand beyond the 101,000 sq. ft. to what is called the Kroger Marketplace. The store will carry goods beyond the normal grocery items such as furniture and other hard lines.

A local construction firm, Flexxon Operating Ltd., is building the complex. Grading of the property is currently underway.
