E.E. Robinson Park Expansion Plan!

The engineering firm Precision Planning has been selected to design and engineer the 18 acre addition to E.E. Robinson Park.

The new addition will feature a full tournament sized baseball field with lights, bleachers, a playground, locker room, and other support facilities. There will be an additional 260 parking spaces, a pedestrian trail, and vehicle access linking to the rest of the park. Access from Peachtree Industrial Blvd. will be limited to special events.

Applications for renewal were sent in December. It is crucial for all businesses to make any changes on the application and to fill in the portion requesting gross receipts or the number of professionals and mail this back to the City. Invoices will then be generated and mailed. The licenses will be mailed upon receipt of payment.
