

The City of Sugar Hill  
Plaza Security Patrol Actions  
Jan.27th, 2017 – Feb.02nd, 2017

- The following actions are specific significant actions taken during normal patrols throughout the City. Plaza Security patrols the City on a daily basis and any criminal act is forwarded immediately to the Gwinnett County Police Department. Security officers request any illegal activity be reported to them and also be reported to Gwinnett County Police Dept. Plaza Security acts as additional eyes and ears for the City and provides assistance when needed; however, they are not a police agency.
- 01-27-17- The Officer preformed routine patrols of both residential and business properties in an attempt to observe and/or deter illegal activities. Included in these patrols were the P.O.A.P.'s. The Officer while on patrol at 20:00 hrs. received a call from the on duty Shift Supervisor in reference to a suspicious person. The Supervisor advised that there was a subject in the area of Riverside Dr. and Austin Garner Rd... The Officer made an extensive an extensive search of the area without any contact. The Officer advised the Supervisor that he had conducted an extensive search of the notated areas and including adjacent areas and advised that he had negative contact and was back in service. The Officer while patrolling The Oaks at Lanier observed a suspicious vehicle in the area of the pool closest to the Whitehead Rd. entrance, of which appeared occupied. This was determined from the windows being fogged up. The Officer activated his high beams on the patrol car in order to illuminate and disorient the occupant/s. Upon approaching the vehicle the Officer could see two subjects. When the Officer inquired why they were up there they advised that the driver, of who was crying was having issues at school, and his friend was trying to console him. The Officer made a visual check of both subjects ID's to verify their ages and that at least one lived in the subdivision. After this was completed the Officer returned to service. At 21:07 hrs. the Officer received a cell phone call in reference to a suspicious male who stands in her back yard with a camera. The call came in 45 mins. after the event. The Officer still made an attempt to locate the subject but had negative results. The Officer advised the complainant to call when she first sees the subject and either Plaza Security L.L.C., or GCPD would respond. The Officer went back on patrol, concluding with the locking of Gary Pirkle. The Officer did not observe any other issues nor was the Officer informed of any other activities or incidents.
- 01-28-17-Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business properties. This also included, but was not limited to the P.O.A.P.'s. No incidents or issues were observed by or reported to security personnel.
- 01-29-17-Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business properties. The patrols included but were not limited to P.O.A.P.s for suspicious activity. No issues or incidents were observed by or reported to security personnel.
- 01-30-17- Officer made routine patrols of all P.O.A.P.'s, not neglecting residential and business properties. No issues or incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security LLC, personnel.
- 01-31-17- The Officer made routine patrols of both business and residential properties looking for suspicious and/or illegal activity/s. This did not exclude the P.O.A.P's listed. No issues or incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security LLC, personnel.
- 02-01-17- The Officer made routine patrols of the city for suspicious or illegal activity/is. These included business, residential and P.O.A.P.'s. No incidents or issues were reported to or observed by Plaza Security LLC personnel.
- 02-02-17- The Officer made routine patrols of both business and residential properties to check for illegal activities. These checks included but were not limited to P.O.A.P.'s. No incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security, L.L.C. personnel

Patrols also cover all other subdivisions.
