

ORDINANCE TO AMEND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CODE

The Mayor and Council of the City of Sugar Hill, Georgia, hereby ordain that Chapter 6 of the Alcoholic Beverage Code of the City of Sugar Hill, Georgia shall be amended as follows:

By amending Section 6-300 of Article IV and Section 401 of Article V by deleting them in its entirety and replacing with the following:

Sec. 6-300. Issuance of licenses to designated area

No licenses permitting the retail sale of malt beverages and wine for consumption on the premises shall be granted to any applicant hereunder unless the proposed premises for the sale of malt beverages and wine for consumption on the premises is a restaurant, hotel or lounge and is located in the appropriate zoning district permitting such use as provided by the zoning ordinances of the city as now or hereafter amended. Such sales shall be permitted in the following zoning districts: BG, HSB. This section does not apply to businesses located in the Town Center Overlay (TCO).

Sec. 6-401. Issuance of licenses to designated area

No license permitting the retail sale of spirituous liquor for consumption on the premises shall be granted to any applicant hereunder unless the proposed premises for the sale of spirituous liquor for consumption on the premises is a restaurant, hotel or lounge and is located in the appropriate zoning district permitting such use as provided by the zoning ordinances of the city now or hereafter amended. Such sales shall be permitted in the following zoning districts: BG, HSB. This section does not apply to businesses located in the Town Center Overlay (TCO).
