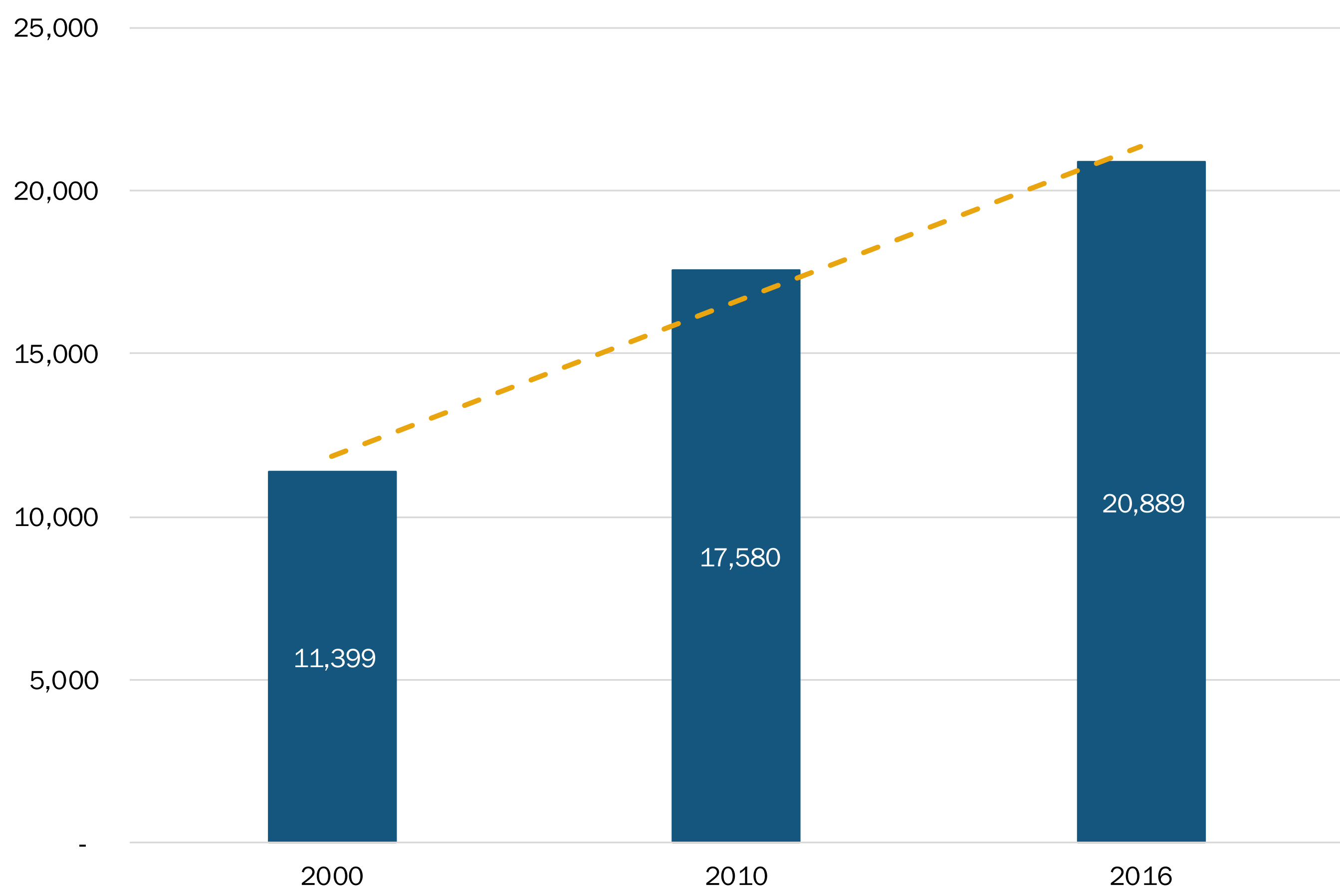


POPULATION GROWTH

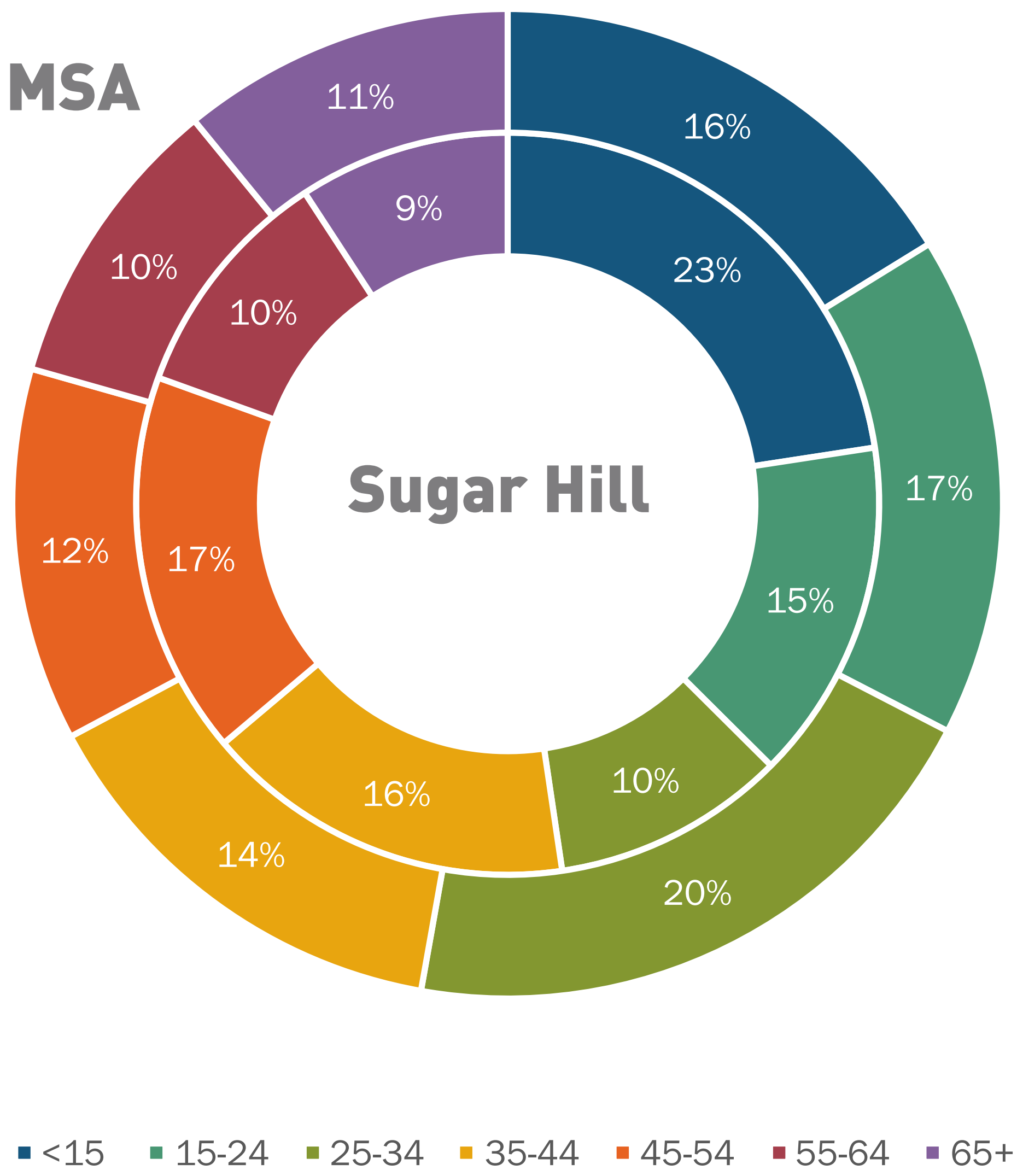


Between 2000 and 2016, the population in the City of Sugar Hill nearly doubled.

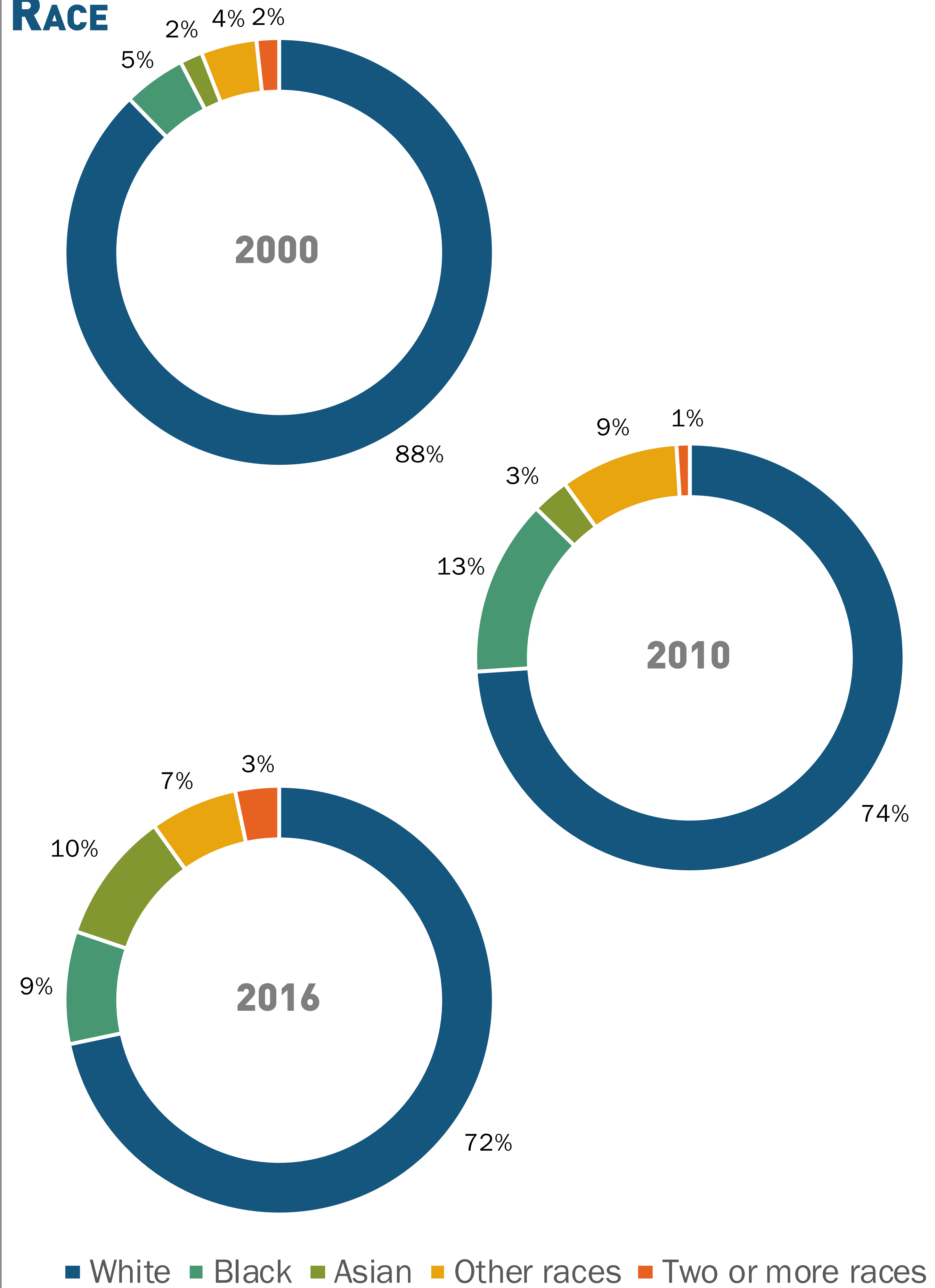
AGE DISTRIBUTION

In 2016, the age distributions in the City of Sugar Hill and the Atlanta MSA were relatively similar. The biggest differences were found in the cohorts below the age of 35. While the Atlanta MSA has a greater percentage of individuals between the ages of 15 and 34, Sugar Hill's population of those under the age of 15 is greater.

RACE



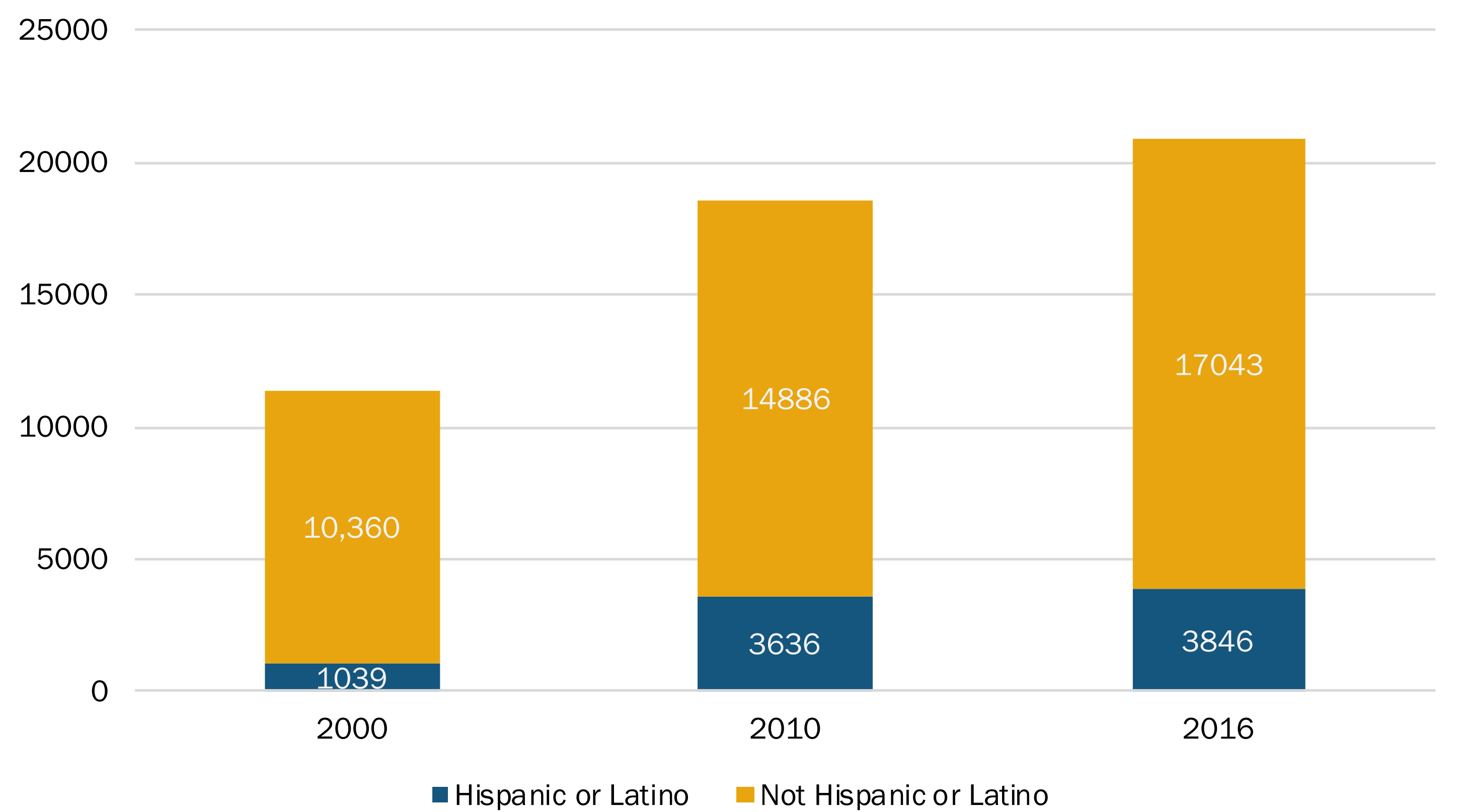
Between 2000 and 2016, the population of Sugar Hill became more diverse, seeing increases particularly in black and Asian populations. While the black population rose from 5% to 13% in 2010 and then dropped back to 9% in 2016, the Asian population has grown significantly in more recent years, from 3% in 2010 to 10% in 2016.
