



RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Georgia convenes in January of each year for a legislative session; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sugar Hill, Georgia, desires to amend its Charter for the purposes of designating certain parcels of land for incorporation into and inclusion within the boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Sugar Hill believe that the designation of certain parcels of land for incorporation into and inclusion within the boundaries of the City is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Sugar Hill; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Sugar Hill propose the following described lands be annexed to the existing corporate limits of the City of Sugar Hill, Georgia; to wit:

All those tracts or parcels of land shown on a map titled 2019 Legislative Annexation Proposal City of Sugar Hill dated March 11, 2019 and set forth in a list of tax parcel identification numbers as found in the Gwinnett County tax records as of July 1, 2018, said map and list of tax parcel identification numbers being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part of this resolution and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, this area proposed for annexation by local act of the General Assembly during this 2019 legislative session is calculated to be a total of 3,278 acres of which 1,157 acres or 35 percent is comprised of any lot or tract five acres or less in size on which is constructed a habitable dwelling unit.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sugar Hill that each of the State Representatives and State Senators elected for Gwinnett County should support legislation during the 2019 Session of the General Assembly an annexation by amending the Charter of the City by local act of the Georgia General Assembly.
