COVID-19 Update

Weds Mar 25 - Gwinnett (and all cities inside Gwinnett) - All gyms, fitness centers, fitness studios, theaters, live performance venues, bowling alleys, arcades, and other similar establishments are temporarily closed.

Restaurants, food courts, catering facilities, brewpubs, breweries and other eating establishments within Sugar Hill may continue to offer food to customers through delivery, takeout and/or drive-thru service.

Monday, March 23 - Temporary Suspension of Yard Waste Collection Services (Yard waste required 4 city workers in a truck in close proximity to each other)

Monday, March 23 - Advanced Disposal:

Bag Service: Limiting the number of green logo bags to 3 bags of household trash **Cart service:** collection will be limited to what fits into the cart with lid closed. All bulk (over sized items) waste collection is suspended until further notice.

Friday, March 20 - City declared State of Emergency for City

Declaring State of Emergency gives additional flexibility and functionality in a time of crisis, including allowing teleconference meetings for groups such as the City Council (Sunshine laws), as well as enabling the City to apply for or receive reimbursement for state and Federal funds if it becomes necessary in dealing with the COVID-19. It also allows City personnel to take other measures, if necessary, to protect life during this emergency.

Thursday, March 19 - Suspension of In-Person Services at City Hall

Monday, March 16 - Gary Pirkle Park is closed to the public until further notice. Sugar Hill Post Office is closed until further notice.
