In Recognition of American Legion Post 127 - Sugar Hill

WHEREAS, The American Legion was chartered and incorporated by Congress in 1919 as a patriotic veterans organization devoted to mutual helpfulness; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion is the nation's largest wartime veterans service organization, committed to mentoring youth and sponsorship of wholesome programs in communities, advocating patriotism and honor, promoting strong national security, and continued devotion to fellow servicemembers and veterans; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion Post 127 was established in Buford in 1921 and resided on Sawnee Avenue between 1948 and 2019; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion Post 127's Sugar Hill location has one of the largest memberships in Georgia; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion Post 127 – Sugar Hill is home to the American Legion Riders, the American Legion Auxiliary, and the Sons of American Legion; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion Post 127 - Sugar Hill is focused on community, supporting Veterans and their families, and providing a place of camaraderie for its members; and
