The City of Sugar Hill will hold a Special Election on November 2, 2021, to fill the following seats:

City Council Post #1, formerly held by Brandon Hembree who resigned to run for Mayor City Council Post #3, formerly held by Susie Walker who resigned to relocate

The election will be held in conjunction with the General Election at Sugar Hill City Hall, 5039 West Broad Street on November 2, 2021, during the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

The Election Superintendent requests that the Mayor and City Council ratify the Call to hold the Special Election and set the qualifying dates and times as follows: Qualifying for this election will be held on Wednesday, September 15, 2021, until Friday, September 17, 2021, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. The qualifying will take place in the office of the City Clerk and Election Superintendent at 5039 West Broad Street, Sugar Hill. The qualifying fee is \$108.00. The legal ad ran in the Gwinnett Daily Post on August 29, 2021, and again on September 5, 2021.
