AGENDA ITEMS FOR THE COUNCIL MEETING – Present were Mayor Brandon Hembree, Mayor Pro Tem Taylor Anderson, Council Members Marc Cohen, Mason Roszel and Jenn Thatcher, City Manager Paul Radford, Assistant City Manager Troy Besseche, City Clerk Jane Whittington and City Attorney Frank Hartley.

AWARDS AND PRESENTATIONS/PROCLAMATIONS

Proclamation CDAT – STEM Program Lanier High School – Council Member Thatcher will present to Mike Reilly at the March 14th Council Meeting.

Proclamation Natural Gas Utility Workers Day – Assistant City Manager will read the proclamation at the March 11th Council Meeting in honor of the City's gas department.

OLD BUSINESS

RZ-21-009, ACR Engineering, Inc., 1250 Hickory Hills Dr., rezone from MH to R36 for 12 Cottage Court Units (public hearing 3-14) – Planning Director Awana explained that this was discussed at last months Council Meeting. The public hearing was held then. The project is for twelve cottages with a small square footage. They have secured the capital reserve in the homeowner's association of \$10 to \$20,000 for repairs that could possibly be needed in the future.

NEW BUSINESS

RZ-21-011, Elmington Residential, 27.7 acres Sycamore Rd. from RS-100 to RS-72 for 87 Home Subdivision (public hearing 3-14) - Planning Director Awana explained that this is for eighty-seven units that are single-family rentals. The homes would be 1600 to 2000 square feet for up to four bedrooms. The Planning Commission voted to deny RZ-21-011, but staff recommends approval with three conditions.

GDOT Pedestrian Lighting Agreement, Highway 20 – Assistant City Manager Besseche explained that this agreement would cover the portion of Highway 20 that is in the city limits. It is one agreement so when the property is developed individual lighting agreements would not be necessary for each project.

Adopt Parking Ordinance Amendment – Assistant City Manager Besseche explained that this ordinance amendment created a new chapter of the Sugar Hill Code entitled Traffic and Vehicles. The code was silent on enforcement and standards for on-street parking. This will allow the city to implement time-specific on-street parking restrictions for the downtown area.

GDOT Right of Way Easement Request – Assistant City Manager Besseche explained that the city participates in an IGA with Gwinnett County and staff is recommending that this piece of property be dedicated at no cost to the county or the state for the easement.
