Protecting Your Civil Rights is Good Business

It is our policy to ensure that no person in the United States of America shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any of our programs or activities.



The City of Sugar Hill hereby gives public notice that it is the policy of the City to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities.

Any person who believes they have been subject to unlawful discriminatory practices under Title VI has the right to file a formal complaint. Any such complaint must be filed in writing or in person with the City of Sugar Hill, City Clerk's Office, 5039 West Broad Street, Sugar Hill, Georgia 30518.
