
Get Some Fresh Air on the New Sugar Hill Greenway



Did you know that part of the new Sugar Hill Greenway has been completed? You can now run, bike or take a leisurely stroll up and down 2,000 linear feet of the trail along Level Creek Road. The concrete path is part of 16.5 miles of trails and open space planned by the City of Sugar Hill. Made up of pedestrian paths and bicycling lanes, the trail starts in downtown and will eventually connect Sugar Hill Elementary, both E.E. Robinson Parks and Gold Mine Park, a new city greenspace and trailhead.

The Sugar Hill Historic Preservation Society (SHHPS) and the Sugar Hill Arts Commission (SHAC) are proud to collaborate on "Charlotte Elizabeth Edwards Howerton: This is My Story, This is My Song" **May 14 through June 24, 2021**. The exhibit, named after a manuscript written by Charlotte during her illustrious, prolific and adventurous life, showcases her writing, art and historical relics in both the new Sugar Hill History Museum and Art Gallery.

Charlotte was born January 27, 1916 in her family home on Level Creek Road, the oldest house in Sugar Hill. The Sugar Hill Historic Preservation Society exists to discover, promote, and preserve the rich history of Sugar Hill. Since formation, the Society has worked with the city and residents to discover gold mines in the area, preserve historic grave sites, record the history of the area, and much more!
