SUBJECT: Resolution to adopt the Project Framework Agreement

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt resolution to approve the Project Framework Agreement for preliminary engineering with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT).

DISCUSSION

- The City of Sugar Hill was awarded Federal Aid Highway Program (FAHP) funds to complete preliminary engineering toward implementation of our Sugar Hill Greenway Extension plan which was conceived through the Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) grant program in 2020.
- The project includes enhancements to pedestrian infrastructure and intersection improvements along sections of Alton Tucker Boulevard, Level Creek Road, Stanley Street, SR20, and Peachtree Industrial Boulevard.
- Improves safety and convenience of walking and biking to the downtown area.
- Promotes accessibility to transportation options expanding city-wide connectivity with the greenway as outlined in the LCI plan.
- Investments in pedestrian and bicycle mobility options are investments in traffic safety, air quality and economic development.
- GDOT project number: 0019214.
- Federal award: \$720,000.
- Local match: \$180,000 (20 percent).
