Call for 2023 Municipal General Election

The City of Sugar Hill will hold a General Election on November 7, 2023, to fill the following seats:

City Council Post #1, currently held by Mason Roszel

City Council Post #2, currently held by Marc Cohen

City Council Post #3, currently held by Jenn Thatcher

The election will be held at Sugar Hill City Hall, 5039 West Broad Street during the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Advance or Early Voting will be held October 16-21, 2023, from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm; October 23-28, 2023 from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm; and October 30 – November 3 from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm. A run-off election, if necessary, shall be held December 5, 2023. All voting will be held at City Hall, 5039 West Broad Street, Sugar Hill, GA.

The Election Superintendent requests that the Mayor and City Council set the qualifying dates and times as follows: Qualifying for this election will be held on Monday, August 21, 2023, until Wednesday, August 23, 2023, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. The qualifying will take place in the office of the City Clerk and Election Superintendent at 5039 West Broad Street, Sugar Hill. The qualifying fee is \$108.00 for City Council and due at the time of qualifying. The legal notice of qualifying shall run in the legal organ of the City of Sugar Hill two weeks before the qualifying period.
