DRB-CBD 23-001, 4934 Hannah Street, addition to existing single-family home,

Public Hearing 6-12-23 – Planning Director Awana explained that the design review is for the renovation of this existing home on Hannah Street. Gabriel Arroyo submitted an application for renovation of this existing 1,037 sq. ft. house originally built around 1940. The applicant will build a second story and addition.
