Sugar Hill Downtown Development Authority Regular Meeting Minutes Summary

- III. Approval of Agenda Motion to approve the agenda by A. Jorgensen, 2nd by T. Ross (4-0 Unanimous)
- IV. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes Motion to approve previous meeting minutes by T. Ross,

- VII. Updates
 - a. E Center: Commercial Development, Theater, and Recreation (W. Broad St.)
 - i. The Bowl Construction- T. Besseche shared photos of the improvements to the East end of the Bowl focused on stormwater improvements and parking on the backside of the Bowl stage. The second portion of the parking area has been paved and the pavers are one third of the way done. They are working with Georgia Power to set transformers. T. Besseche stated that the Alton Tucker Blvd extension project has been awarded and it will connect Highway 20 with West Broad Street and will include a traffic signal. It will enhance and provide gathering spaces in the downtown area, which can be activated with farmers markers or outdoor weddings. No questions on the project.
 - ii. E-Center C. Rehak discussed signage on the Promenade, lighting, and planters on 39th Street. T. Besseche mentioned the Rooftop opening. T. Semrau stated that retail activity remains strong across all property and there is a close deal for office use at the last remaining space at the E-Center.

- b. Solis Sugar Hill: Mixed Use (Temple Dr.) T. Semrau stated the focus the last couple of weeks has been contacting tenants that serve the local community including, but not limited to, outdoor retailers and active lifestyle stores that service outdoor activities. Specific ones included rock climbing, sports fitness, outfitters to showcase cultural aspects, restaurants, local eateries, and markets that span a different number of food groups. They continue to look at food halls and full-service restaurants that are family friendly. T. Semrau stated they are waiting on lease back from tenants. T. Besseche showed aerial photos of Solis parking deck. The parking deck has been soft opened. No questions regarding Solis.
- c. Skyview/Kittle Homes (Hillcrest) T. Besseche showed images of Skyview demonstrating the basement and first level framed. There will be an update next month on sales.
- d. Sycamore Square/ Lidl (Sycamore and Hwy 20) T. Besseche showed images of Lidl and gave an update on commercial component.
- e. Other Updates
 - i. Talk of the Table C. Rehak stated talk of the table would be open by July 6th.
 - ii. Sparks in the Park C. Rehak stated the band would go on at 6pm and fireworks start at sundown.
 - iii. Air Supply concert C. Rehak stated the concert would be July 9th. S. Nicol asked for ticket sales.
 C. Rehak stated they were sold out.
 - iv. Solis Extra T. Besseche showed designs for Solis parking deck and mentioned a public art component. Mentioned food truck location. S. Nicol asked about location and mentioned proximity to Highway 20.
 - v. Greenway Portion opened for Sparks in the Park for easy access.
 - vi. Ridge Lake Park T. Besseche mentioned developments in the dog park, walking trails, picnic pavilion and septic. More recreational activities could be added in the future.
