Call for Special Election November 7, 2023, Homestead Exemptions – Mayor Hembree explained that the city will be having a special election in November to increase the homestead exemption for Sugar Hill residents. The legislation was passed this year but will take a referendum of the voters of Sugar Hill to increase these exemptions. They are for regular homestead, senior homestead and for disabled or senior that is income based.
