RECOMMENDED ACTION

- 1. Authorize the Mayor to sign and submit the application for the 2nd round of 2024 Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) program for improvements to the proposed list provided in the staff memo.
- 2. Authorize the Mayor to approve a contract amendment with Garrett Paving for the additional streets up to a contract total of \$950,000 (additional \$306,314.17 plus original budget of \$541,870.49, plus contingency).
- 3. Approve attached budget amendment to the CIP recognizing the additional LMIG funds.

BUDGET IMPACT

The project budget for 2024 is \$650,000. A contract with Garrett Paving was awarded in the amount of \$541,870.49. Additional funds from the state will allow an additional \$306,314.17 to be added to the program. No additional local funds are required to complete within a revised \$956,314 total project budget.

DISCUSSION

In September 2023, the city approved for submittal under the GDOT grant program twelve (12) streets as a part of the original FY24 state funding program. Since that time, the state has authorized additional funding for this fiscal year for Sugar Hill in the amount of \$ 306,314.17 for road repairs and resurfacing. No local match is required for the new funds.

With the additional funding at rates in our current paving contract, we should be able to complete repairs on another 1.5 miles for this year. Staff recommends submitting the following streets based on roadway score and location. The streets are listed below with the corresponding lengths and cost, based on the actual unit prices from Garrett Paving, and road condition score; an addition of


some 56% to the original LMIG length (13,470 plus 7,541) resulting in an annual total of 4.5 miles (including 3 carry over streets from 2023-see Feb 2, 2024 memo to Council). Staff recommends approval of these additional six (6) streets be added to the LMIG application for the second round of funding:






