Gary Pirkle Park Streambank Restoration

The City of Sugar Hill, Georgia (the "CITY") is now accepting sealed price proposals from qualified contractors to provide construction services to include all materials, manpower, equipment and supervision in the restoration of a streambank in Gary Pirkle Park. The project is located in Gary Pirkle Park, in the City of Sugar Hill, GA. It is generally to the east of the bridge to the main playing fields in the main parking lot off of Austin Garner Rd. It consists of the restoration of approximately 300' of the eroded streambank of Richland Creek.

Anticipated Construction Activities:

- Restoration of the route of Richland Creek.
- Placing boulders to protect restoration both mechanically and by hand.
- Removing and replacing any landscape necessary, to include trees, shrubs, other plantings, mulch, sod and other grasses, plugs and live stakes.

Other Considerations:

- The pedestrian bridge must remain open during construction.
- The contractor must use methods that do not interfere with vehicular traffic or foot traffic on opposite side of driveway.
- The first bay of parking spaces on the North side of the driveway and the area between it and the creek may be used for laydown and equipment storage.
- Substantial completion shall be November 1, 2024 with final completion no later than November 30, 2024.
