Addendum 1

Questions from 7/9/2024 & 7/10/24 Pre-Bid Meeting

- 1. How can we access the West side of bridge? Bridge has a 20-ton weight limit and can be closed briefly to cross and then reopened for pedestrians. Adequate protection must be installed on bridge to protect surface from damage, include adequate barricades/flagging during use.
- 2. Can the bridge be crossed? See answer to #1 above.
- 3. Do we have to remove debris in channel? Debris should be removed where necessary in the area of construction.
- 4. Is creek diversion OK? Yes, this is left to the contractor to propose in their proposed means and methods.
- 5. Do we need a shop drawing for a diversion? The proposed diversion method will need to be approved by the engineer prior to installation. Sufficient information will be needed to approve the diversion, including, but not limited to, a shop drawing.
- 6. Is a utility license sufficient? Utility license is sufficient
- 7. Is a GC license sufficient? Or do we need both? Either a utility license or a GC license is sufficient
- 8. Who will do utility locates? It is on private property.
- 9. Will we be dumping and spreading under and around bridge, or do we need to grade? Where existing rip rap is present, the rip rap will need to be refreshed and supplemented to protect bridge abutments. Where no rip rap currently installed, no grading is anticipated, but the area will need to be prepared to allow for proper installation of rip rap on slopes
- 10. Anticipated NTP is September 1.
- 11. Will the city be inspecting materials and installation? City (or Engineer) will be performing weekly inspections. See NPDES compliance matters in question below.

- 12. NPDES inspections? City or Contractor? Contractor
- 13. Saturday and Sunday work? No
- 14. Hours 7A to 7P. No bridge work after 5PM
- 15. Are there dam releases in this creek? No
- 16. Are chain link construction fences required? Adequate protection of the construction area from pedestrians is required. Include orange barrier fence in pricing to secure area of work and laydown.
- 17. Is there a soils report available? No.
- 18. Does the contract anticipate weather days? Yes
- 19. Does the contract contain Force Majure? Yes,
- 20. Will we only have to clear brush? No tree Clearing? Trees to be removed are delineated on the plans. All other clearing can be brush removal.
- 21. Any irrigation in the area? No
- 22. Can you send out plan holder list? Yes
- 23. Do we need to supply porta potty? Yes
- 24. Will we be laying slopes back? Will we be narrowing creek? No slopes will be laid back and no narrowing of creek is proposed. Due to available space constraints, armoring of creek bank, grade stabilization, and regrading of slope is proposed.
- 25. Do we need turbidity curtains? A turbidity curtain is not specified as a sediment control BMP on the plans. A staked turbidity curtain (Tc-S) could be used as a supplemental BMP if needed
- 26. 303b listed Stream? Yes
- 27. Is flume to be added? No, it is existing. Outlet protection should be added downstream of the flume as specified on plans
- 28. Should fabric under rip rap be replaced? Yes, where new rip rap is being installed, fabric should be replaced and re-laid
- 29. Is working in stream allowed? It is anticipated that all work will be done from the banks of the stream. As part of proposal, contractor shall propose means and methods to complete work.
- 30. What utilities are located within the work area? A utility locate shall be performed by contractor. Known private utilities are electrical and sewer
- 31. Where is laydown and access? Laydown areas and site access are shown in the plans
- 32. Will the bid opening be public? Yes
- 33. The budget for this project is \$400,000.
