APPROVAL OF AGENDA – Council Member Hicks motioned to approve the agenda as written. Council Member Avery seconded the motion. Approved 5-0.

2025 Proposed Operation & Capital Improvement Budget Ordinance – City Manager Paul Radford explained the modifications to the budget since it was proposed at the last meeting. They included increases in revenue, eliminating vacant positions, reduced consultants, lowered building upgrades, eliminated new software, reduced Riverlands Authority line item, transfers to capital improvement reduced. The Assistant City Manager updated that the Capital Improvement Budget was reduced by removing the public parking. The pedestrian bridge and the Transco station updates are two big projects for 2025. Council Member Avery asked for clarification that no current employee positions would be eliminated, and the raises were still in the budget. The City Manager responded that is correct.

Council Member Pirkle motioned to approve the budget as presented. Council Member Page seconded the motion. Approved 5-0.
