Budget Amendment & Purchase Authorization

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approve the purchase of a new hook lift truck for the public works department in the amount not to exceed \$185,000 AND approve the corresponding budget amendment.

BUDGET IMPACT

The vehicle referenced in this memo is currently unbudgeted. SPLOST funds are proposed to be used for this purchase. Staff is currently waiting on the final quote from the last dealer.

DISCUSSION

The public works department utilizes hook lift trucks to haul, deliver, and move open-top dumpster containers as a part of the yard debris collection program, the rip rap (rock) deliveries, and bulk waste services. The department is needing to replace one of the older trucks approaching the end of its useful life. Price uncertainty and availability have prompted staff to start researching options for replacement of this, the largest truck in the fleet of these types of vehicles.
