**LMIG 2026 Application** – the Assistant City Manager presented the streets for the 2026 application. The project is estimated to cost \$983,578. The LMIG funding through the state would be \$287,574. A 30% match is required and will be funded by SPLOST.

**Boundary Line Agreement for 1125 Whitehead Road** – the Assistant City Manager explained that the boundary line agreement was contemplated during the design review process for this property. The negotiations and surveys have taken a while and an agreement has been reached. The city will proceed with the installation of the cemetery fence once this agreement is approved.
