OLD BUSINESS

Planning Commission Appointments – Staff to advertise for the Planning Commission in the next newsletter.

NEW BUSINESS

Certified City of Ethics Recertification Resolution – The City received the designation in 2001 and must re-certify every four years. Place on the Consent Agenda.

2015 Budget Amendment – Assistant City Manager Troy Besseche explained that this amendment is for the DDA to complete the remodeling of the Suite Spot. Place on the Consent Agenda.

Unique Refinishers Waiver of Development Regulations Renewal (APPLICANT REQUEST TO TABLE) – The Planning Director explained that the applicant requested to table because his attorney had a schedule conflict.

TCO Design Review Board – Architectural Approval to modify existing ground sign. The Shell gas station at 1330 Peachtree Industrial Blvd. is requesting approval to modify an existing ground sign to make it digital.

VAR-15-001, Gwinnett Church requesting to increase the maximum sign face area for 300 Peachtree Industrial Blvd. (public hearing at the February 9th Council Meeting) – the proposed sign is an aluminum tree, it is dimensional and grey. There was discussion whether the sign is a sculpture and more of a piece of art. The Council can review the sign ordinance at a later date to include structures that are art. The ordinance currently does not have language for art type signs.

Appointment of Historic Preservation Society Members (at February 9th Council Meeting) – Mayor Pro Tem Hembree explained that the members will be appointed at the February 9th Council Meeting.

Recognition of Lanier Middle School Geography Bee Champion & Runner-up (at February 9th Council Meeting) – Mayor Pro Tem Hembree wants to honor them at the Council Meeting. He will send draft proclamation of the City Clerk.
