Sugar Hill is a Safer Place to Work and Live

In an effort to make Sugar Hill a safer city, all full time city employees have received training and certification for Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) operation.

The CPR training taught city employees how to recognize and care for breathing, choking and cardiac emergencies in adults. The main objective was to gain the knowledge and skills necessary to prevent, recognize and provide basic care for injuries and sudden illnesses until advanced medical personnel arrive and take over.

AED machines are used to enhance our life saving skills in cardiac emergency situations. The AED machines will be placed at City Hall, the Sugar Hill Golf Course, the new Community Center on Church Street and the Maintenance Facility on Hillcrest Drive.
