#### NATURAL GAS - Be Safe

When we think about providing natural gas to our citizens, we focus on safety and keeping costs as low as possible.

The meters and regulators that bring the natural gas to your home or businesses are the property of the City of Sugar Hill. With a focus on the safety of all customers, we ask that you not tamper with any part of the meter or meter box. Tampering with any part of the gas system can pose a danger for both the resident and neighbors. The City assesses a minimum \$100 fee if this occurs.
