## Robertson/United Waste – Trash Pick-Up & Optional Service Information

- The "Special Bag" is sold by the box and includes twenty (20), 32- gallon, garbage bags for \$23.44. The cost of these bags includes your curbside household garbage and recycling service. They are sold at Ace Hardware, Kroger, Publix, and Quality Foods retail stores in Sugar Hill only.
- **Recycling** is now picked-up separately from your trash. Trash will be picked up first and then another truck will be dispatched to pick-up the recycling.
- **Roll-Away Carts - Only the contents within the roll-away carts will be collected.** The cost of this service is \$34.35 for a 90-gallon cart and \$28.05 for a 35-gallon cart, billed quarterly.
- "Bulky Waste" must have one (1) "Special Bag" attached to each item and be easily visible to the collection crew.
- **Hazardous Materials:** Residents can call any company that specializes in the removal of hazardous materials. For example, you may call SHINALL RECYCLING at 770-564-1511.

Place your "Special Bags", garbage carts, recycling bins, and bulky items within five (5) feet of the curb or roadside by 7 AM each Wednesday.
