




ONE STEP CLOSER TO OUR NEW CITY HALL

The group went through many design reviews until we finalized the construction plans. In addition we interviewed several construction firms, and ultimately selected a partnership of Van Winkle & Associates and Reeves Construction to build our new City Hall








