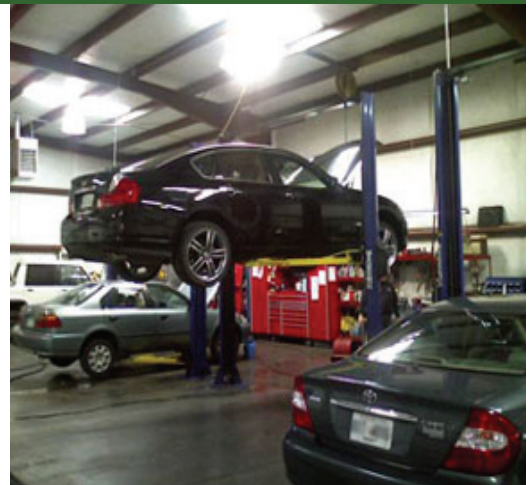

- Leaves and healthy streams! What do leaves have to do with the health of streams? Leaves that are blown or swept into the street wind up in drainage ditches or storm drains. They are washed into local streams where bacteria causes the leaves to decay and release phosphorus. This bacterial action can lead to a decrease in the water oxygen levels necessary to support the survival of aquatic life. How can you help? Don’t blow or sweep leaves into the street, storm drains or drainage ditches. Instead, consider composting the old leaves. If you bag the leaves, the City picks them up free of charge! *“The Drain is Just for Rain”*
