## Construction Watch: New and Ongoing



Development continues in E.E. Robinson Park. The City has purchased additional property along Level Creek Rd, and is creating additional parking. A new entrance is being constructed that will relieve congestion during major events

in the park. Pictured above is the additional parking lot, and on the left is the turn lane on Level Creek Rd. Also as part of the project will be shaded picnic areas. This construction includes the regional water detention pond.

## Last Day to Register to Vote is October 6th!

It's important to register to vote in the coming national elections. If you have moved, are new to the State, or just turned 18, you have until October 6th to register. If you have not voted in the last two general elections you may be listed as inactive so you must re-register. You will need a form of identification. They include a copy of a current and valid photo ID, a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows your name and address. Registration forms are available at Sugar Hill City Hall, the Gwinnett Public Library or Gwinnett County offices. Remember to bring a photo ID to the polling place in order to vote. ## Cemetery Fence Design Approved for West Broad Street

As part of the development of West Broad St, the City has voted to enclose the cemetery with a traditional fence with features that will complement the new downtown. After several reviews of six proposals both the Mayor and City Council, and the Downtown Development Authority, agreed on a brick and wrought iron fence with three decorative gates. The City has received five proposals for the construction and installation of the fence. After reviewing the proposals we will interview three firms for a selection.
