With their financial sponsorship, 160 young adults came to Sugar Hill to paint, reroof, and build handicap ramps and minor repair to needy residents with-in the City. The City received several applications from residents that needed repairs to maintain their home. After a review by the W.C. construction manager, ten homes were identified meeting the requirements for repairs and were selected for work. This is the first World Changers project in Sugar Hill and the City welcomes the opportunity to partner with them in the future.

Public Service Announcement for Sugar Hill Gas Customers

If you smell Gas inside your home:

- Leave the house immediately!
- Make an emergency call from a neighbor's home.
- Do not take time to shut off valves or open windows.
- Wait at the neighbors until a certified gas technician arrives.

Make note of these numbers to call, keep them along with other emergency telephone numbers

If you are unable to remember these numbers call **911**

Underground piping beyond the meter. Sugar Hill operates a safe, well maintained underground gas system in accordance with Federal Regulations. Any underground gas piping beyond the meter is the responsibility of the customer. If not properly maintained, metallic pipes may be subject to corrosion. Make sure any underground piping beyond the meter is properly maintained.

Call before you dig - It's the law. Please contact the Georgia One Call Center at (770) 623-4344 or 811, three days prior to digging in order for all utility owned buried pipe and cable to be located. All the digging should be carefully done by hand in the vicinity of the pipe. This service is available free of charge. Call the Sugar Hill Gas Department for information: (770) 271-2137
