City Hall Steel Framing Progressing





Despite the wet winter, the steel framing is progressing rapidly. The City of Sugar Hill Parks and Recreation Department has teamed up with Stewards of Children to offer a Sexual Abuse Prevention Seminar Stewards

Stewards of Children is a training program (produced by www.darkness2light.org) that equips adults to protect children from sexual abuse. Statistics show that 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys will be sexually abused before their 18th birthday and this course is a great first step towards insuring the safety and protection of our children. Far too often, the responsibility to stop child sexual abuse is put on children rather than adults. Believing that child safety is the responsibility of adults, this training focuses on educating and equipping adults with information and tools to protect the children in our community.

This training will be facilitated by Mike Sloan, husband, father, and Sugar Hill resident, who is trained as a *Darkness to Light* facilitator.
