## The City of Sugar Hill Plaza Security Patrol Actions Oct.10th, 2016 – Oct.16th, 2016

- The following actions are specific significant actions taken during normal patrols throughout the City. Plaza Security patrols the City on a daily basis and any criminal act is forwarded immediately to the Gwinnett County Police Department. Security officers request any illegal activity reported to them also be reported to Gwinnett County Police Dept. Plaza Security acts as additional eyes and ears for the City and provides assistance when needed; however, they are not a police agency.
- 10-10-16- Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business locations, and additional patrols of P.O.A.P.'s for suspicious activity. No incidents were observed by or reported to security personnel.
- 10-11-16-Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business properties. This also
  included, but was not limited to the P.O.A.P.'s. The Officer while on routine patrol observed a
  suspicious person/vehicle on Commerce Parkway. The vehicle was a red Jeep Rubicon occupied
  by two males. When the Officer made contact he inquired if the subjects worked at any of the
  businesses, the Driver stated no. The Officer stated that they were on private property and were
  trespassing. The Officer then advised the subjects that should anyone not authorized to be
  caught on the powerline property that GCPD would be called and that they were subject to arrest.
  The Officer also advised the subjects to pass the word along to their friends that Plaza Security,
  and GCPD Officers were monitoring the area and prosecution was going to result if they were
  caught on the property. The subjects left without incident. No other incidents or issues were
  observed by or reported to security personnel.
- 10-12-16-Officer made routine patrols of both residential and business properties. The patrols
  included but were not limited to P.O.A.P.s for suspicious activity. No issues or incidents were
  observed by or reported to security personnel.
- 10-13-16- Officer made routine patrols of all P.O.A.P.'s, not neglecting residential and business
  properties. The Officer was informed via cell phone from the burglar alarm monitoring company,
  of a burglar at the Sugar Hill City Hall. The Officer responded and checked the building. Upon her
  check she located a Sugar Hill employee of who had been in his office when the alarmed was
  armed. Without knowing this when he exited his office he set off the alarm. The Officer
  recognized that the subject as having authorization to have afterhours access to the building and
  went back in service. No other issues or incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security
  LLC, personnel.
- 10-14-16- Officer while on patrol made multiple area checks of the city park for suspicious and/ or illegal activity/s. The Officer also made routine patrols of both residential and business properties, including P.O.A.Ps. No incidents were observed by or reported to security personnel.
- 10-15-16- The Officer made routine patrols of both business and residential properties looking for suspicious and/or illegal activity/s. This did not exclude the P.O.A.P's listed. No issues or incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security LLC, personnel.
- 10-16-16- The Officer made routine patrols of both business and residential properties including the P.O.A.P.'s for suspicious and/or illegal activity/s. During the Officer's tour of duty no incidents were observed by or reported to Plaza Security LLC personnel.
